

### **Information for students: In-person classes**

BEOC is closed to the public.

During the Spring 2021 semester, the Center will have onsite classes for Medical Assisting and Direct Support Professional students. The classes are for hands-on practice that cannot be conducted virtually.

These are the general requirements for students attending in-person classes at BEOC:

- Only students with scheduled classes are allowed onsite
- Students may only be onsite for their specific classes
- Students must be tested for Covid-19 within three days of their first scheduled class
  - Students must test every two weeks thereafter

- Students must complete health screening and show Everbridge approval each day
- Students should follow instructions of screeners upon entry to BEOC
- Students should enter at 111 Livingston Street entrance, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor
- Students should exit on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor
- Students must follow social distancing, wear face coverings, and follow floor markings

Students will receive additional specific class/lab related protocols with their course-related information in Schoology, the student learning management system.
