



## **January 2022: Update on in-person classes for Spring 2022 semester**

BEOC is closed to the general public.

During the Spring 2022 semester, the Center will have onsite classes for Medical Assisting, Direct Support Professional, and Office Administrative Professional students. The classes are for hands-on practice or labs that cannot be conducted virtually. ***Classes will be held at 111 Livingston Street.***

In addition, upon completion of the semester, High School Equivalency and Medical Billing and Coding students will have onsite certification testing.

### ***In-person schedule:***

Medical Assisting 1<sup>st</sup> term – February 4, 2022

Medical Assisting 2<sup>nd</sup> term – April 2022

Direct Support Professional – April 2022

Office Administrative Professional 2<sup>nd</sup> term – March 2022

High School Equivalency and Medical Billing and Coding – June 2022

### ***Categories for vaccination status:***

1. Fully vaccinated: 14 days after final dose of vaccine\*
2. Vaccinated: Completed one of two doses **or** not yet completed 14 days after final dose
3. Exempted or waived: Received official approval for exception to the vaccination requirement

\*Students are encouraged to get their booster doses as recommended by the CDC and NYS Health Dept.

### ***General requirements for students attending in-person classes/activities at BEOC:***

- Only students scheduled for in-person classes, review sessions, or testing are allowed onsite
- Students attending in-person classes or activities should be fully vaccinated (two weeks after final dose)
- Students who are not fully vaccinated (see vaccination category 2 above) by the time they are due to start in-person classes should contact [CampusAccess@beoc.cuny.edu](mailto:CampusAccess@beoc.cuny.edu) to get directions. They may request approval to take weekly Covid-19 tests until they reach fully vaccinated status
- Students who are not vaccinated due to documented medical or religious reasons must apply for a waiver by completing an application and providing the appropriate supporting documentation. Note that exemptions are not granted automatically and will take some time to be processed
- Instructions on how to upload vaccination proof or request an exemption from the vaccination requirement will be provided directly to students by email or postings in Schoology

### ***Feeling sick or tested positive for Covid***

- Students who experience flu-like symptoms such as persistent cough, chills or a positive Covid test, should stay home; they should not come to in-person class or activities
